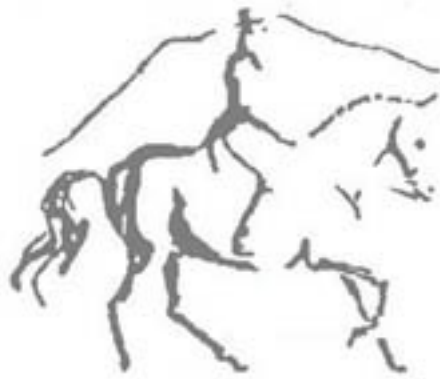

Rules and General Information

Directions: From South 101 North to Highway 37 East to Lakeville Hwy. Go north to sign "Riverside Equestrian Center" on left.

From North 101 South to Highway 116 to Lakeville Hwy, Petaluma. Go south to sign "Riverside Equestrian Center" on right.

Rules: Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Awards: Awards to first place in classes with three or more entries. Ribbons to 5th place. Amateur and Junior divisions will be designated if there are three or more entries.

Footing: Footing in warm up and competition arenas is sand and rubber. Covered arena is warm up and is 200x100 ft. Competition arena is in covered arena and is sand footing.

Judges: It is the purpose of the Management to run the Horse Show at the highest possible level of sportsmanship. The Management used the utmost care to select judges with broad experience and knowledge. The judges' decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and the Management accepts no responsibility for those decisions.

Stabling: Limited stabling available. Stalls are 12x12 permanent with solid or gated door. Day and overnight stalls must be reserved in advance through show management. **\$25/day.**

CDS members who participate in a CDS recognized show may not be required to pay non-member fees to any other organization (National Federation - USEF or National Breed Organizations exempted) in order to participate in the show. For CDS recognized shows in California, Nevada, Arizona and Oregon, CDS agrees to a reciprocal non-member system where CDS will waive the non-member fee IF the competitor and/or owner is a member of another USDF GMO; and in return the show management will not charge CDS members a non-member fee for any other GMO. If the competitor and/or owner is not a member of CDS or any other GMO, then the show management will charge and collect non-member fees for CDS.

Class Fees: Training – Fourth, \$45

Add "A" to class number if competing as an amateur; amateur card must accompany entry. Add "J" to class number if junior.

ENTRY AGREEMENT - ALL PROVISIONS APPLY

Our non-agen/participant agrees that show management is merely providing enabling for the convenience of the participant and that management, the sponsoring organizations and the facility shall have no responsibility whatsoever for any injury, loss, damage, etc., as a result of using said enabling. Our non-agen/participant agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold all sponsoring and recognizing organizations, show management, their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers harmless from any loss, damage or claims as a result of said use. Our non-agen/participant assumes all care, custody, and control with regard to this use. Our non-agen/participant agrees that every horse entered or which they bring to the show grounds will be subject to the rules of the horse show management but that neither the horse show management nor any sponsoring organization will, in any case, be responsible for damage, as a result of any loss, damage or claim that may occur. They agree to defend, indemnify and hold the horse show facility, horse show management, their directors, officers, officials and/or volunteers and a third organizational harmless therefrom.

I hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless USDF, its instructors, officers, directors, agents and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities. I also hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless the show management, show committee and members, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-sponsored Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Valet or Longeur and on behalf of myself and any principal, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audio, videotape, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action brought against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GRI 502.5

FEDERATION RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION. This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this competition _____] to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, valet, coach, trainer, agent, coach, valet, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including break on horses, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GRI 318 and EV 111, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WAKING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that the "Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.
